Tidbits about the Hilltoppers.....

- *The Peoria Journal Star* predicts Mt. Pulaski will finish fourth in the Tomahawk Conference behind Hartsburg-Emden, Illini Central and Delavan.
- They won the Sangamo Conference last season.
- The last two years Mt. Pulaski has placed 2nd and 3rd in the Holiday Classic.
- The Hilltoppers went undefeated in the Peoria Heights Thanksgiving Tournament to start the season at 4-0.
- The Mt. Pulaski JV team also started the season undefeated and won the Peoria Christian Thanksgiving tourney.
- Coach Jumper enters his third year behind the bench at Mt. Pulaski. Before that, his junior high teams at Bowen Southeastern and Elkhart won more than 600 games. His sophomore team record was 180-29. In all, he has over 850 wins if you combine every level that he has coached on.
- Jumper is an alumnus of Illinois State University.
- Assistant coach John Niebrugge was an assistant on the 1998 Teutopolis team which reached the Elite Eight.
- Josh Blaum was named Special Mention on the 2003-04 IBCA All-State team.
- Blaum, John Foley and Chris McDonnough were selected to the all-tournament team at the Peoria Heights Thanksgiving Tournament.
- Foley, along with his brother Paul who plays on the JV team, are both Eagle Scouts.
