## Tidbits about the Indians.....

- Hyde Park won a Regional title last year, eventually losing to Chicago Simeon 69-57 in the Sectional Championship.
- According to *The Chicago Tribune*, the Indians are projected to finish 4th in the Public League Red-East division behind Chicago Washington, Chicago Dunbar and Chicago Vocational. The paper lists Victor Brown, Artero Goodman and Raphael Woodson as players to watch.
- The Chicago Sun-Times* picks them to finish 3rd in the Red-East division, and mentions Brown and Woodson as two of the Top 5 players in the conference.
- The Indians were ranked as high as #4 in the Chicago area and #16 in the state last season, the first time in history they had been ranked that high.
- Woodson is receiving interest from Lewis University, Chicago Loyola, and Chicago State University.
- Brown is receiving interest from Chicago Loyola and Ball State University.
- Spencer Brown has a 3.5 GPA and scored a 28 on his ACT.
