Tidbits about the Streaks.....

- Galesburg and Normal U-High have each won more games in the history of the Holiday Classic (46) than any other participating boys' teams.
- *The Peoria Journal Star* predicts the Streaks will finish in fifth place in the Western Big Six Conference.
- Head coach Jeff Houston was an all-conference player at Carl Sandburg College in Galesburg, and also played a year at Northeast Missouri State (now Truman State) and two years at Monmouth College, where in 1989 he was MVP as a senior.
- Joel Dieterich was named Special Mention to the 2003-04 IBCA All-State team.
- STAT Scout Hoops ranks Dieterich as the 27th best Junior in the state and has this to say: "Joel is a quick guard who is a leader on the floor. Joel is a great decision-maker when it comes to finding an open teammate. In addition to his passing skills, he is also one of the best all-around ball handlers in the state. Look for Joel to have a great season this year." They also rank him as the 4th best ball handler and passer in the state, as well as a Top 10 defender.
