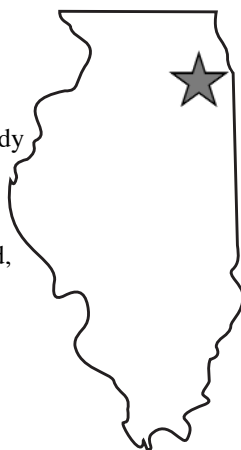

### Tidbits about the Steelwomen.....

- The Steelwomen are making their first appearance ever in the Holiday Classic.
- According to *The Chicago Tribune*, Joliet is projected to finish second in the SICA West Conference behind Orland Park Sandburg. The paper lists Ashley Easley and Shantel Johnson as players to watch.
- The Steelwomen return eight letterwinners from a 19-11 team last season which finished in third place in the SICA West Conference.
- Terri Shrishuhn is in her first season as coach at Joliet. She used to coach at Plainfield South.
- Ashley Easley is considering playing college basketball at Yale University next year. She was selected Honorable Mention on the IBCA All-State team last season and was also named All-SICA West Conference. She has a 4.8 grade point average and ranks 19th out of 484 students in her senior class. Member of the National Honor Society.
- When Joliet was without a coach this past summer, Easley was also one of the main players that organized the team's summer participation in leagues and tournaments. The Steelwomen went 18-5 this past summer, with a big win over Orland Park Sandburg who is currently ranked 6th in the Chicagoland area by *The Chicago Tribune*.
- Shantel Johnson was one of the Tribune's Top Five Freshman two years ago.
- Ebony Ellis is receiving interest from several local universities.
- Former Steelwoman Cathy Boswell is a graduate of Illinois State University and played basketball on the 1984 gold medal Olympic team. Her jersey number was retired by ISU and she is the Redbirds all-time leading scorer.
